TAZEWELL COUNTY HEALTH LDEPARTMENT

The Tazewell County Health Department was established by referendum and organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, chapter 410 for the purpose of providing its residents with the following services and programs:

1. Administration and Organizational Support
2. Food Sanitation
3. Potable Water Supply
4. Maternal Health and Family Planning
5. Child Health
6. Communicable Disease Control
7. Private Sewage Disposal
8. Solid Waste
9. Nuisance Control
10. Chronic Disease
11. Dental Health
12. Nutrition Services
13. Institution and Jails

The Tazewell County Health Department has certain functional divisions which are shown on Table 1 attached hereto. The amount of the operation budget for the current fiscal year is attached. The Department's main office is located at Tremont, Illinois, off State Route 9. The Dental Health Clinic is located at 429 Court Street, Pekin, Illinois. The Department currently employs approximately 80 full and part-time employees.

The Health Department is governed by a 11-member Board of Health which has a broad range of powers and duties in accordance with State Statute (Chapter 410). The members of the board of the Tazewell County Board of Health are as follows:
