## -Welcome to 21st Century Schools -

The Tazewell County Health Department in cooperation with Bethel Lutheran School is proud to offer the extended day program. The program is administrated by 21st Century Schools, a department of TCHD. This before and after school program is housed at Bethel Lutheran School.

21st Century Schools also provides before and after school services in several other schools throughout the county. Program components focus on academics, life skills education, parental involvement, service learning, positive adult mentors and recreation/cultural activities.

The program at each site is administered by 21st Century Schools Staff which consists of a site coordinator and support staff.

### Extended Day Information:

This structured latch key program is offered mornings and afternoons each day when children are in attendance for at least half of the school day. The daily program includes breakfast and an afternoon snack. Programming at each site may include small group activities, quiet time, crafts, large and small motor activity and supervised play. The extended day program operates on a prearranged basis. In order to provide adequate supervision, food, and supplies children must be pre-enrolled in the program. Parents are billed for services and payment is due in advance.

Each Friday payment and schedule are due for the following week. Rates for the sessions are \$4.00 for the morning, \$6.00 for the afternoon or \$10.00 for both the morning and the afternoon session. Parents must complete registration forms located in the Parent Handbook prior to the student attending the program. Parent Handbooks can be obtained at the school office or with the site coordinator.

### Conference/ Early Dismissal Days:

On Early Dismissal days when students are released prior to 1:30 pm, students can stay after-school and enjoy special activities planned. The rate for early dismissal days is \$14.00 with snack included.

All day services may be available on no school days if the minimum attendance requirement is met. Interest forms for these days will be sent home with students.

### Enrollment Information:

The first day of morning and afternoon services will be on Thursday, August 20th.

*Students will not be enrolled in the Extended Day Program until all required program paperwork, first weeks prepayment and schedule is received.*

Your receipt for this payment will be considered **your child's enrollment confirmation**. If two weeks have lapsed with no payment received, Extended Day services will be discontinued until past due amounts are paid in full.
