The Tazewell County Health Department in cooperation with District 108 is proud to offer the PEAK extended day program. The program is administrated by 21st Century Schools, a department of TCHD. The program is housed in each of the schools in the district.

21st Century Schools also provides before and after school services in several other schools throughout the county. Program components focus on academics, life skills education, parental involvement, service learning, positive adult mentors and recreation/cultural activities.

The program at each site is administered by 21st Century Schools Staff which consists of a site coordinator and support staff.

Extended Day Information:

This structured latch key program is offered mornings and afternoons each day when children are in attendance for at least half of the school day. The daily program includes breakfast and an afternoon snack. Programming at each site may include small group activities, quiet time, crafts, large and small motor activity and supervised play.

In addition to the regular extended day activities, enrichment services will be available for children to attend at no additional cost depending on the number of sessions they attended for those activities held on-site. These activities may include Spanish class, sign-language, cooking class, sports and many others. The site coordinator at your building will assist in coordinating services for your child.

The extended day program operates on a prearranged basis. In order to provide adequate supervision and food, children must be pre-enrolled in the program. Parents are billed for services and payment is due in advance. Each Friday payment and schedule are due for the following week. Rates for the sessions are \$6.00 for the morning, \$7.00 for the afternoon or \$13.00 for both the morning and the afternoon session. Parents must complete registration forms located in the Parent Handbook prior to the student attending the program. Parent Handbooks can be obtained at the school offices or with the schools PEAK Site Coordinator.

Conference/ Early Dismissal Days:

PEAK Fun Days camps are available on conference/institute days and will be held at one site within the districts. Students will partake in many activities such as crafts, team building games, field trips, movies and more. Flyers will be sent home regarding programming on these days. Rates for Day Camps are \$22.00 per day with breakfast and snack included.

On Early Dismissal days when students are released prior to 1:30 pm, students will remain at their own site with special activities planned. The rate for early dismissal days is \$14.00 with snack included.

Enrollment Information:

Students will not be enrolled in the PEAK Extended Day Program until all required program paperwork, first weeks prepayment and schedule is received.

Your receipt for this payment will be considered your **child's enrollment confirmation**. If two weeks have lapsed with no payment received, Extended Day services will be discontinued until past due amounts are paid in full.
