



PRE-PACKAGED FOOD FOR RETAIL SALE

Labeling 3-602.11 Food Labels

A) Food packaged in a food establishment, shall be labeled as specified in law.

B) Every food pre-packaged in advance of retail sale shall have the following information in English on its label:

1. The common name or adequately descriptive identity statement.

2. If made from two or more ingredients, a list of ingredients and sub-ingredients in descending order or predominance by weight.

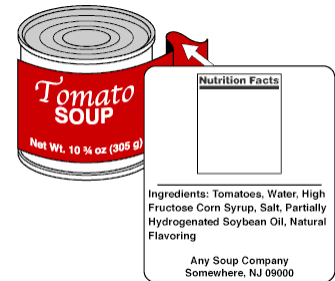
3. The net quantity of the package.

4. The name and place of business of the manufacturer, packer or distributor.

5. The name of the food source for each major food allergen contained unless the food source is already part of the common name.

6. A statement of artificial flavoring, artificial coloring, or chemical preservative shall be placed on the food or on its container or wrapper.

7. Any salmonid fish that contains canthaxanthin or astaxanthin as a color additive, shall have a list of ingredients and disclose the use of canthaxanthin or astaxanthin on the label of the bulk fish container.



C) Bulk food available for consumer self-dispensing shall be labeled with the following:

1. The manufacturer's or processor's label provided with the food.

2. A card, sign or other method of notification that includes information specified in B) 1, 2, 6.

D) Bulk unpackaged foods such as bakery products and unpackaged foods portioned to consumer specification do not need a label if:

1. A health nutrient content or another claim is not made.

2. There are no state or local laws.

3. Food is manufactured or prepared on the premises of the food establishment or at another food establishment or food processing plant that is owned by the same person and is regulated by the food regulatory agency that has jurisdiction.
