What is the High Risk Infant Follow-Up Program?

The High-Risk Infant Follow-Up Program is a free, voluntary service provided by the Illinois Department of Human Services. It is offered to parents and children referred by local hospitals.

This program helps coordinate care between your doctor and other services. It does not replace your child's doctor. We work with your doctor to promote the growth and development of your child.

Most children are referred because of a concern identified at birth. Some children are eligible due to family situations.

Whether this is a significant or minor condition, we are ready to answer your questions and make sure you have the resources you need.



Visits at milestone ages, and as needed



Home visits with a registered nurse from birth to age 2 years



Physical assessments



Developmental screenings



Referral to community resources and additional services
