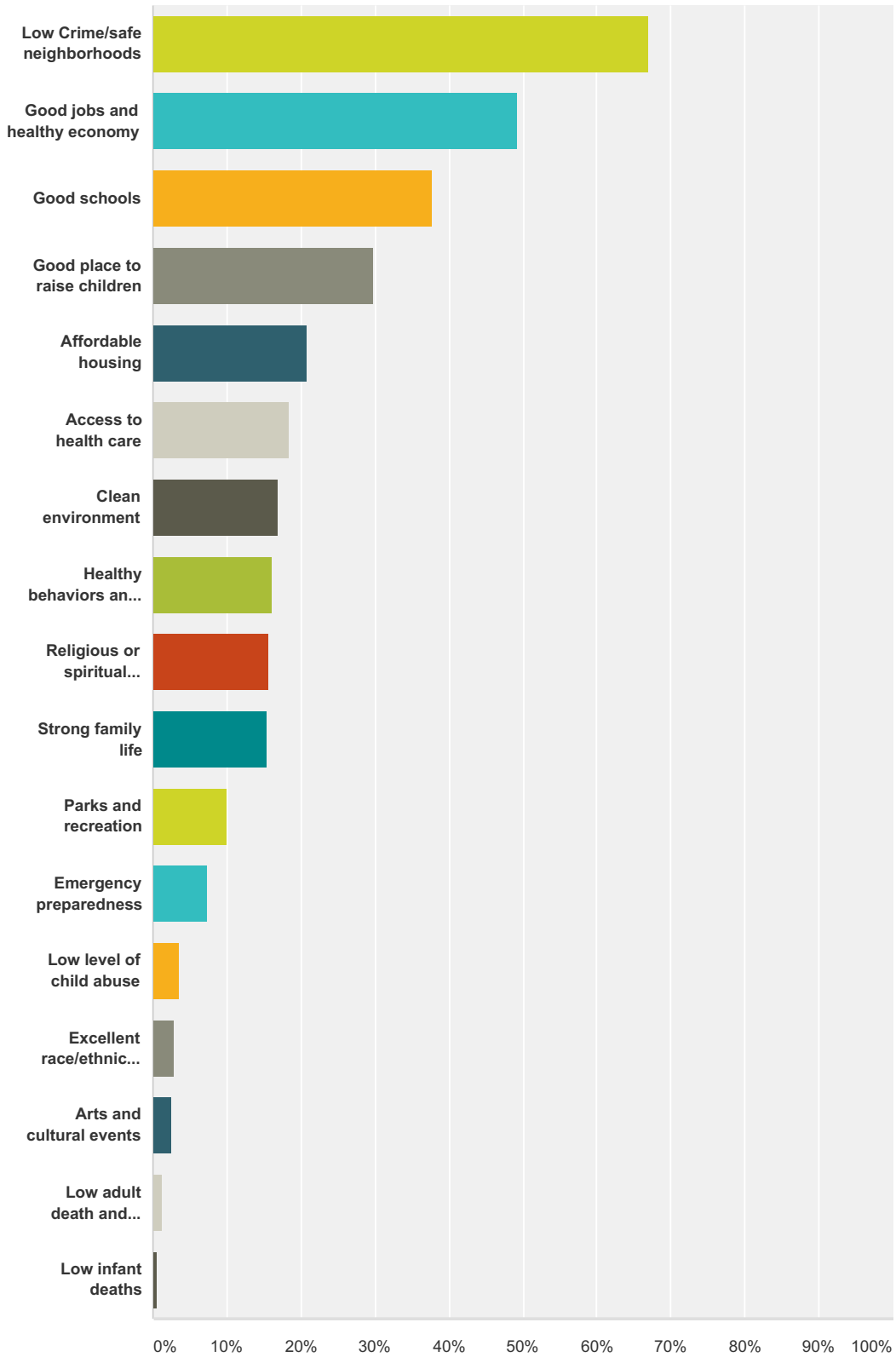


Q1 In the following list, what do you think are the three most important factors for a "Healthy Community"? (Those factors which most improve the quality of life in a community). Choose 3.

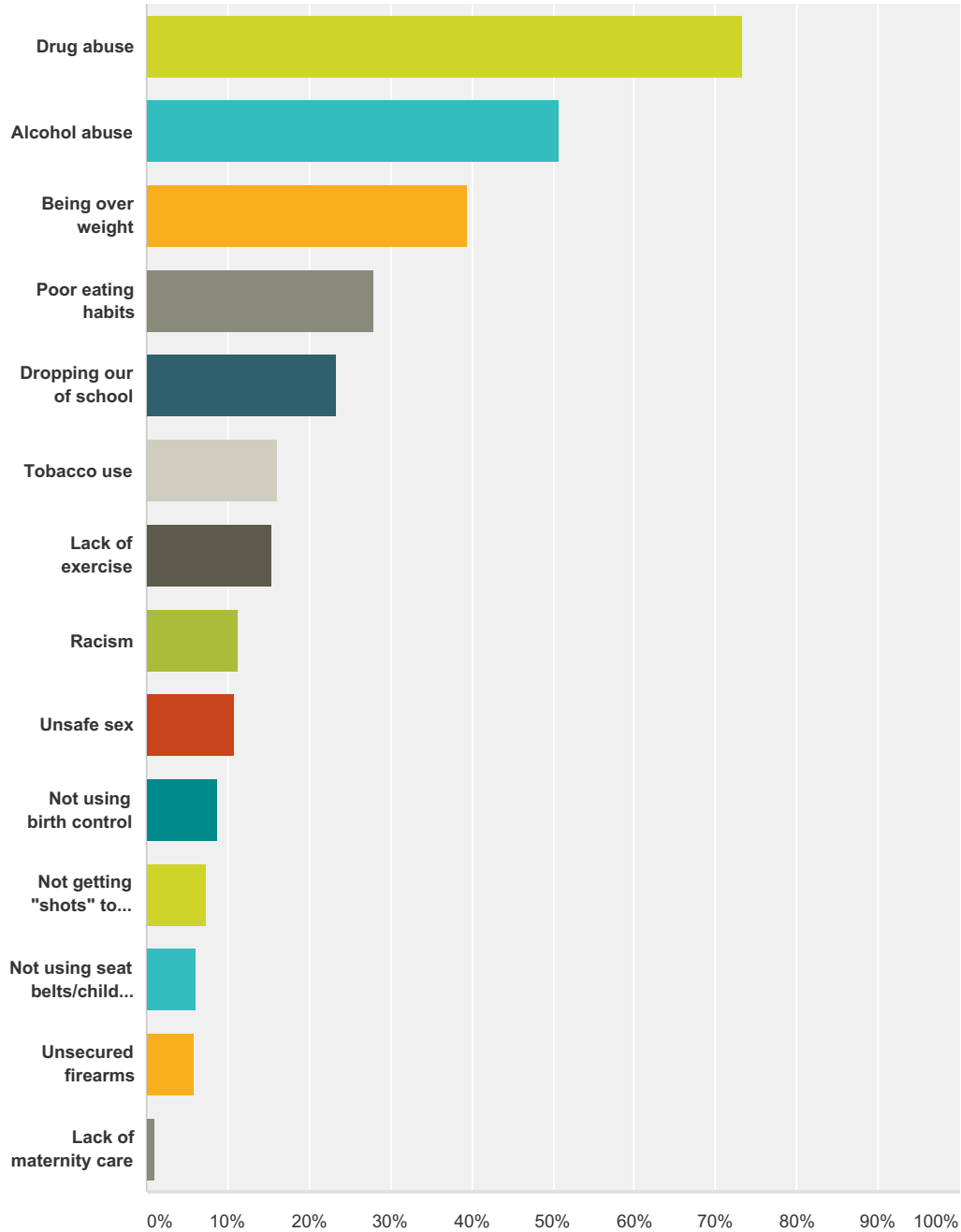

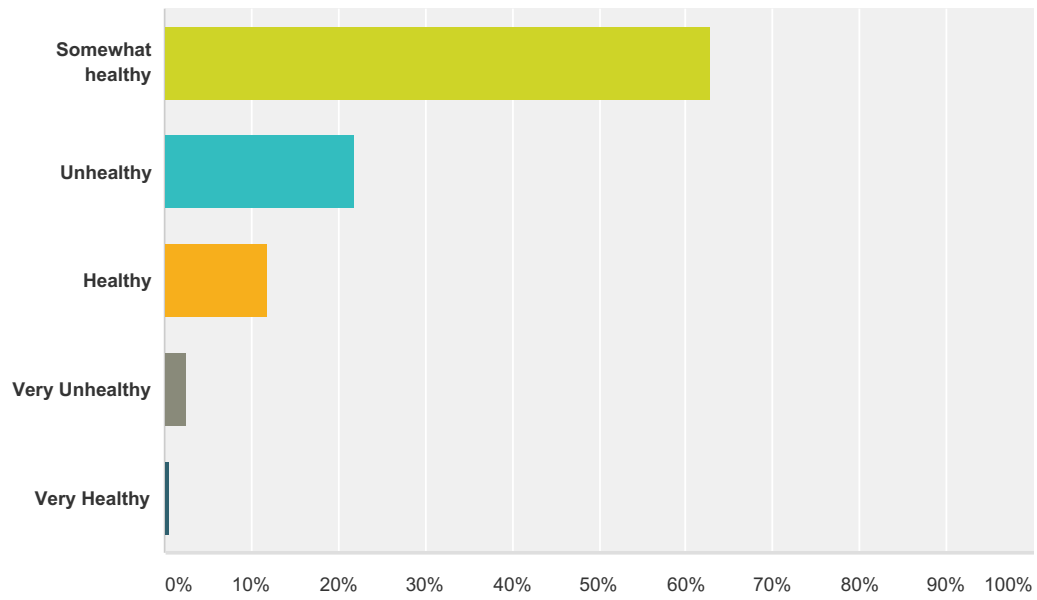

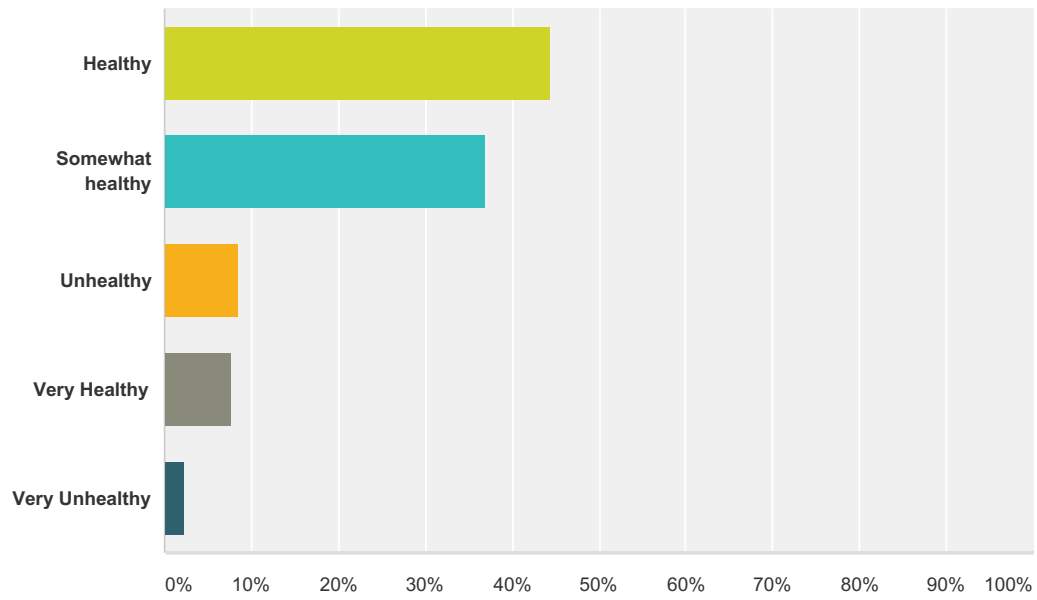

Q5 How would you rate your own personal health?

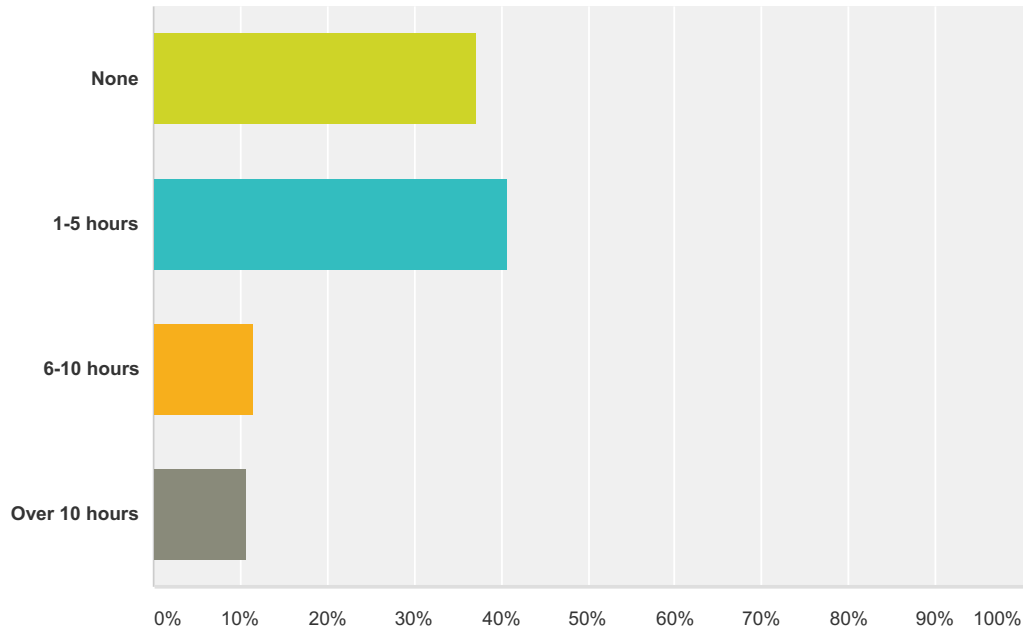

Q6 Approximately how many hours per month do you volunteer your time to community service? (e.g., schools, voluntary organizations, churches, hospitals, etc.)

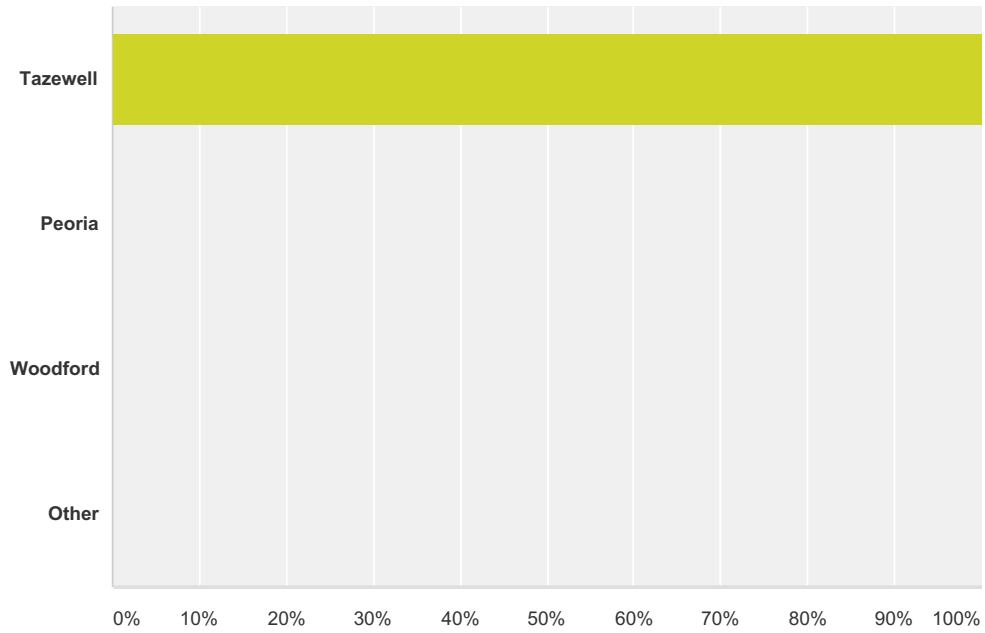

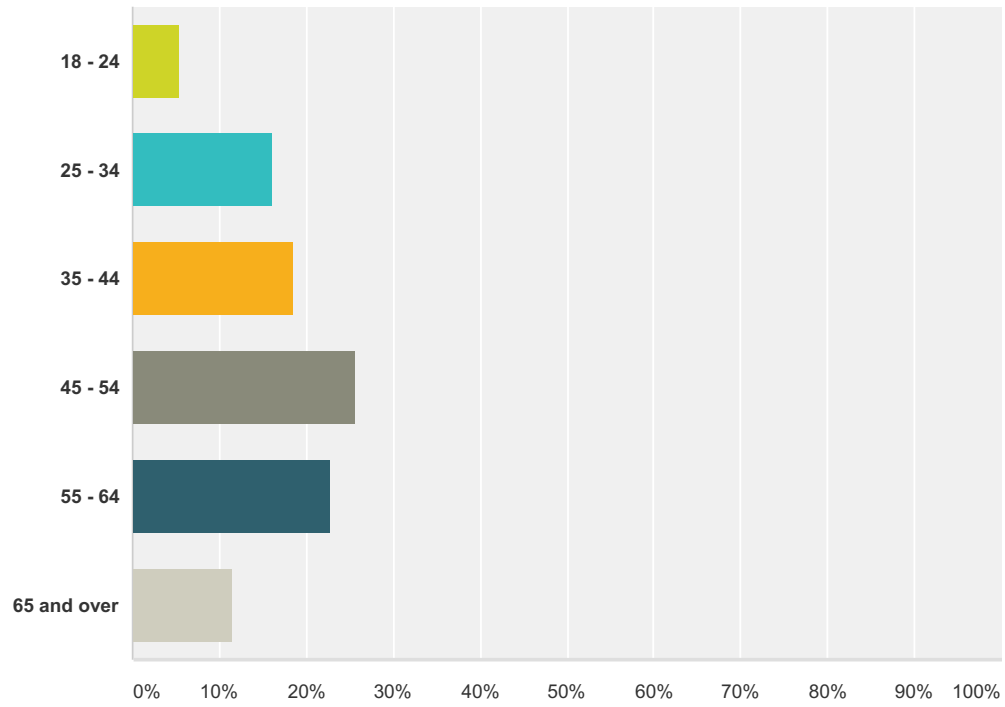

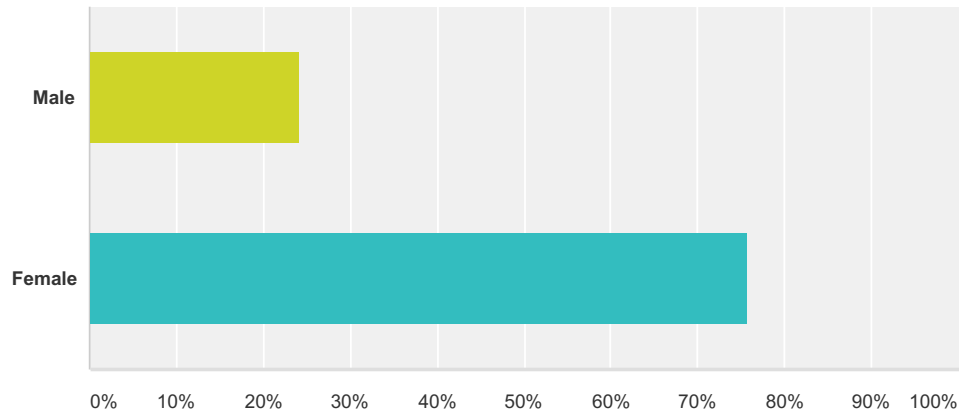

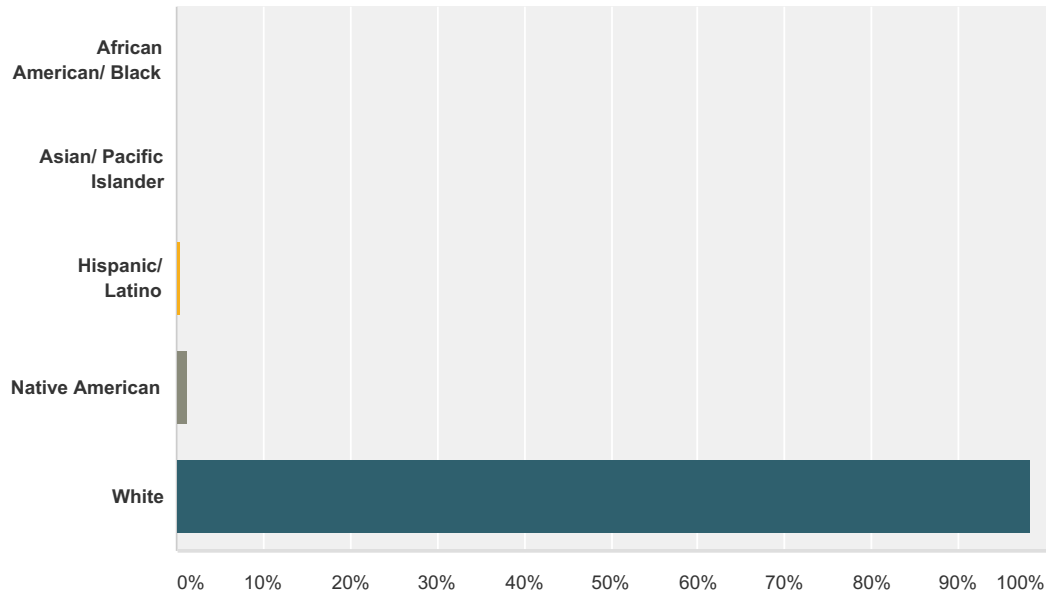

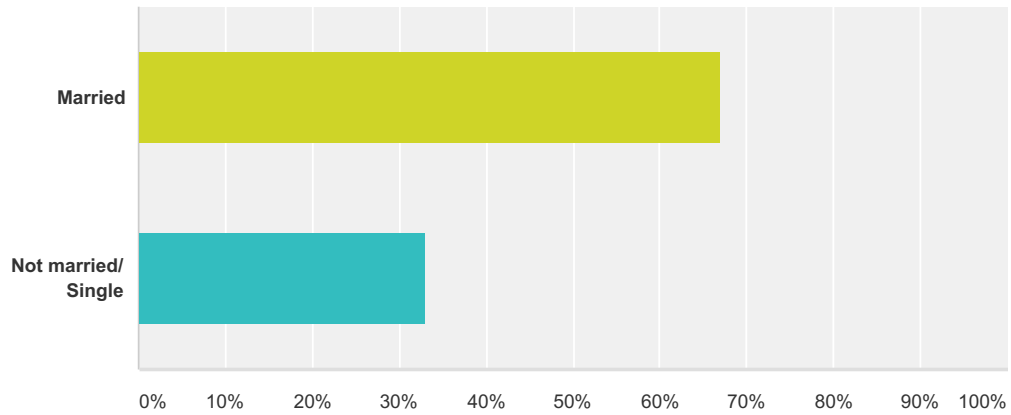

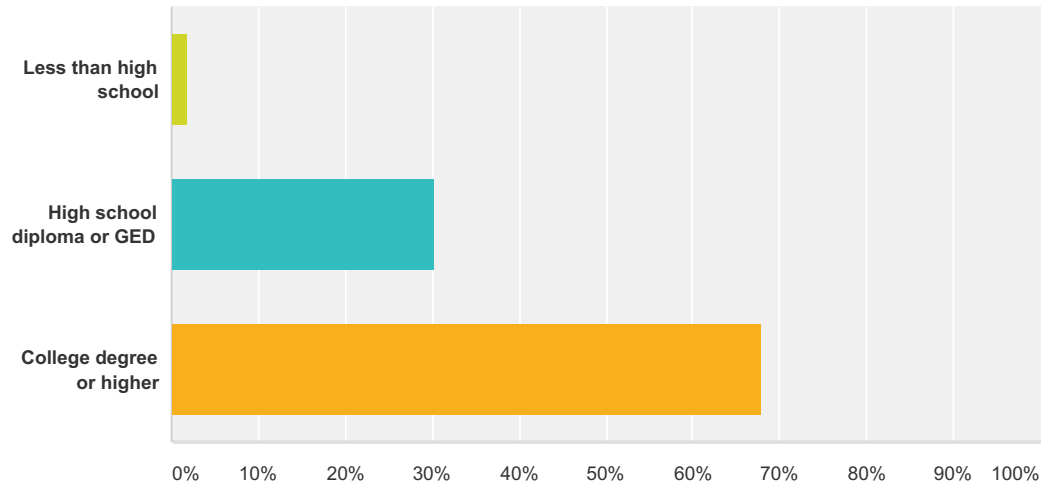

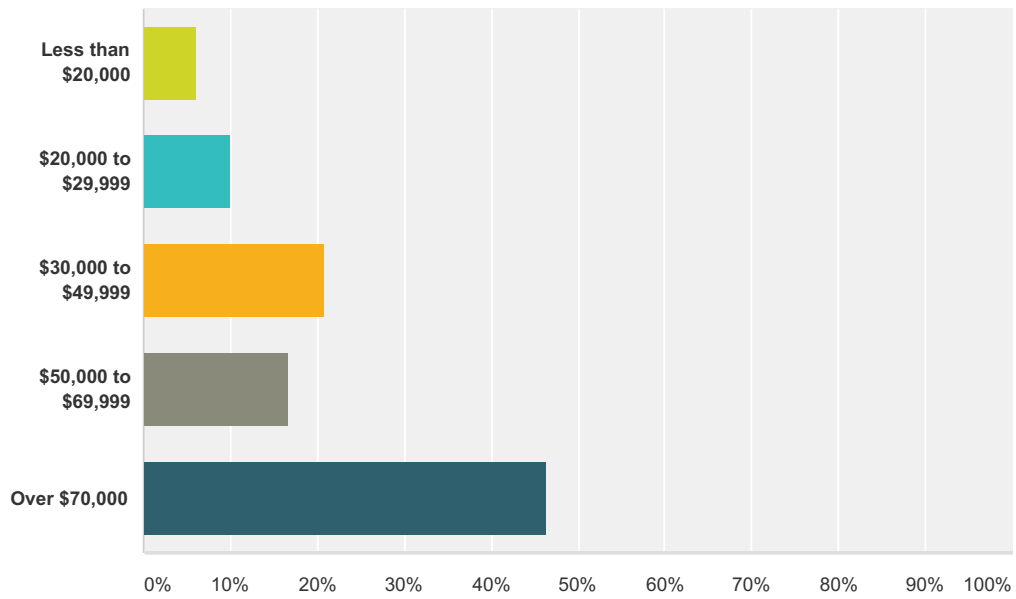

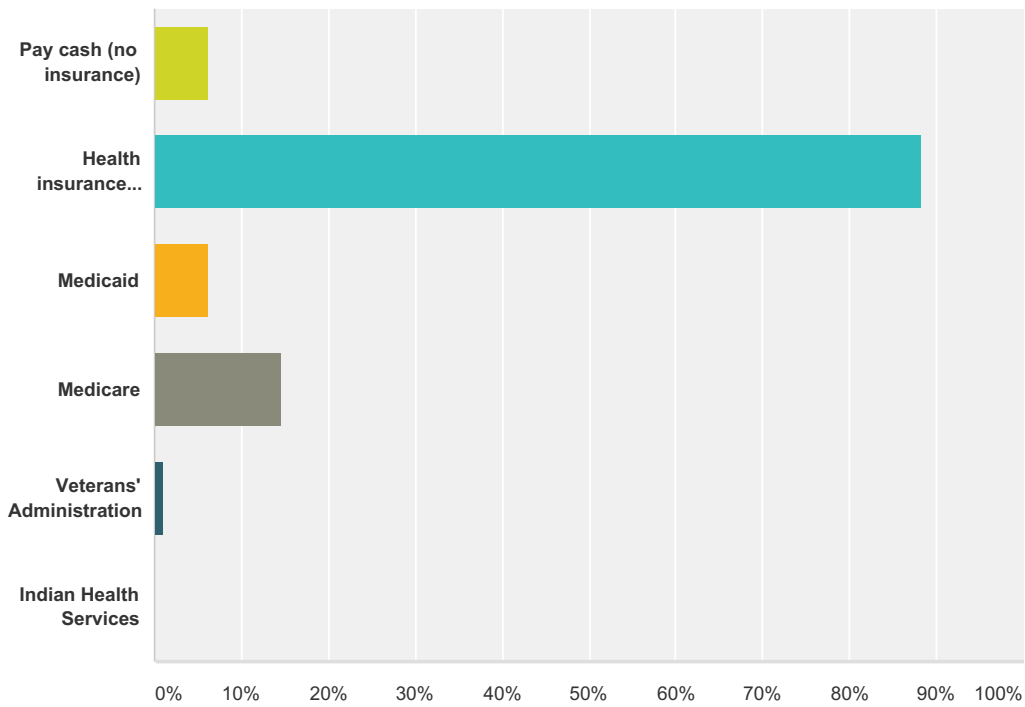

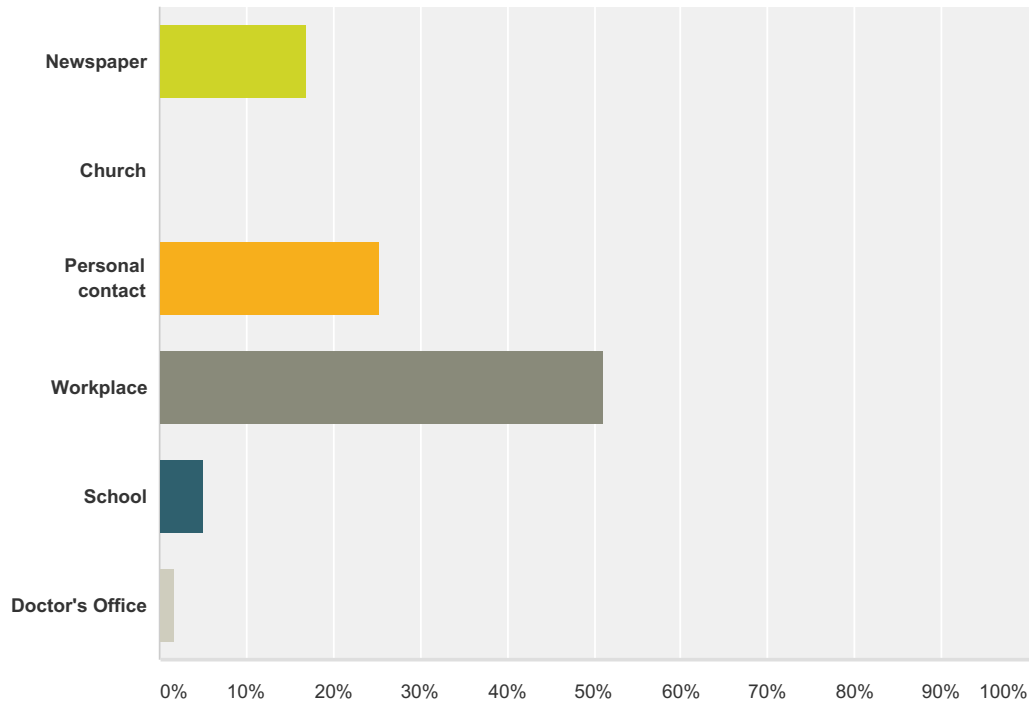

Q17 How did you learn about this survey?

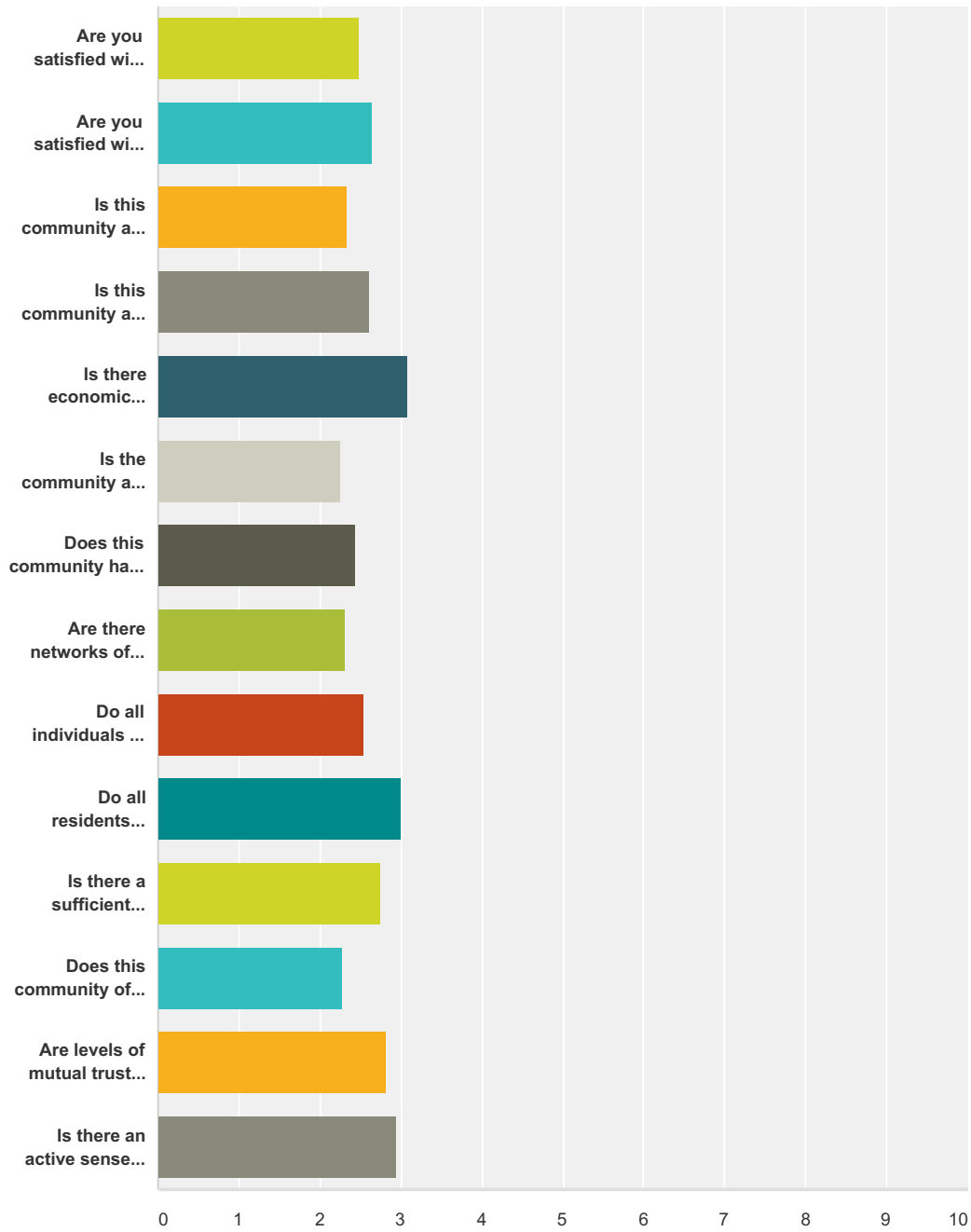
