Immunization Clinic

Tazewell County Health Department (TCHD) will reopen clinic as of Friday, June 5. Because client safety and health are top priorities, TCHD is implementing new processes. All services will be by appointment only. No walk-ins will be allowed at this time. Health screenings and face coverings (for those over age two) will be required. Staff will also wear face coverings. Services available include immunizations, titers and TB testing. Appointments are available Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays 12pm-4pm and Thursdays 8am-4pm. Please call 929-0320 to schedule. Please have insurance card available as this information will be collected at this time.

WIC Clinic

The Tazewell County WIC clinic has been operating remotely since April due to COVID-19. They are continuing to complete WIC requirements telephonically and bringing WIC coupons to clients as they wait in the TCHD parking lot. The plan is for this to continue through June and adjustments will be made as per Illinois WIC guidelines.

Healthworks Transition

The Healthworks of Illinois transition to Illinicare medical case management has been delayed. Currently the plan is for Healthworks to continue with medical case management for youth in care until June of 2021.

Insurance Transition

The transition for youth in care from standard Medicaid to Youthcare has been delayed. At this time a transition date has not been released.

Family Sun Safety

- Look for shade, especially during mid-day hours.
- Wear sun protection gear like hat with wide brim, long sleeves/pants and sunglasses to protect your face, body and eyes.
- Apply a thick layer of broad spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of 15 or higher at least 15 minutes before going outside, even on cloudy and overcast days. Reapply sunscreen at least every 2 hours and after swimming, sweating or towel off. Consult your pediatrician about applying sunscreen to infants.
